- Working since 2010
- Currently integrated by 15 universities. Coordinated by Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona
- Objectives:
 - Potentiating networking among universities to improve associated mobility patterns according to sustainability, equity and efficiency
 - Sharing criteria, methodologies, and strategies
 - Sharing best practices
 - Elaborating and sharing technical information

Working methodology

- Yearly working plan
- 2/3 meetigns per year within the meeting of CRUE Sostenibilidad (group work sessions and results sharing in the Plenary)
- Constant virtual work







Main outcomes

- Spanish Universities accessibility and mobility policy
 - Desirable mobility model: sustainable, efficient and inclusive
 - Strategic lines
 - Promoting active modes (walking and bicycle)
