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

#### County of Hertfordshire/ University

- Mix of rural villages & large towns (affordability issues)
- Close to London (regulated public transport environment)
- Surrounded by 3 main airports
- Dissected by a number of major road links
- Serviced by two main bus & one main train operator (de-regulated environment)

## University of Hertfordshire & Sustainable Travel

- → University Status 1992;
- → 2,650 Staff; 27,200 Students (FTE) spread over two Campuses
- → Travel Plan Developed 2002 and implemented 2003
  - Full Time Travel Coordinator

#### **Travel Plan Targets**

- → Headline Targets set for September 2018:
  - Staff (60% car, now 69% → down from 82%)
  - Student (20% car, now 29% → down from 35%)

students and staff.





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


## **University Bus Network**

Ticketing App





## **Proposed Cash Reward Scheme**

Staff Entry Enter Campus (by any mode)

Rewarded with: 100 Pts.

Points are example values and would be accumulated over a month and then transferred to payroll automatically (with checks) for cash/reward




Campus

#### **UNO** (Hertfordshire)

- Re-launched website to include, 'live time', on board marketing <a href="http://www.motion-media.uk">http://www.motion-media.uk</a>
- 'Innovation fund' agreed On-demand proposal being explored
- Funding for PhD student requested.
- 'Big Bus Data' Research secured to continue to develop App marketing

#### Uni of Hertfordshire

- Motorcycle/Scooters short term hire (being launched UH in Spring)
- E-car App booking now available and carshare option being explored
- Two UH Sustainable Planning MSc Courses (Feb and April) Transport Policy/Travel planning & 'big' Data Analysis
- Launch of Smart Mobility Research Unit (research, teaching, consultancy & professional (2 Feb, UH)
- www.networknorthamptonshire.co.uk\_now updated







## Some Conclusions

Transport in the future is evolving;

- Shared (on demand)
- Smart (info/booked via smart phones)
