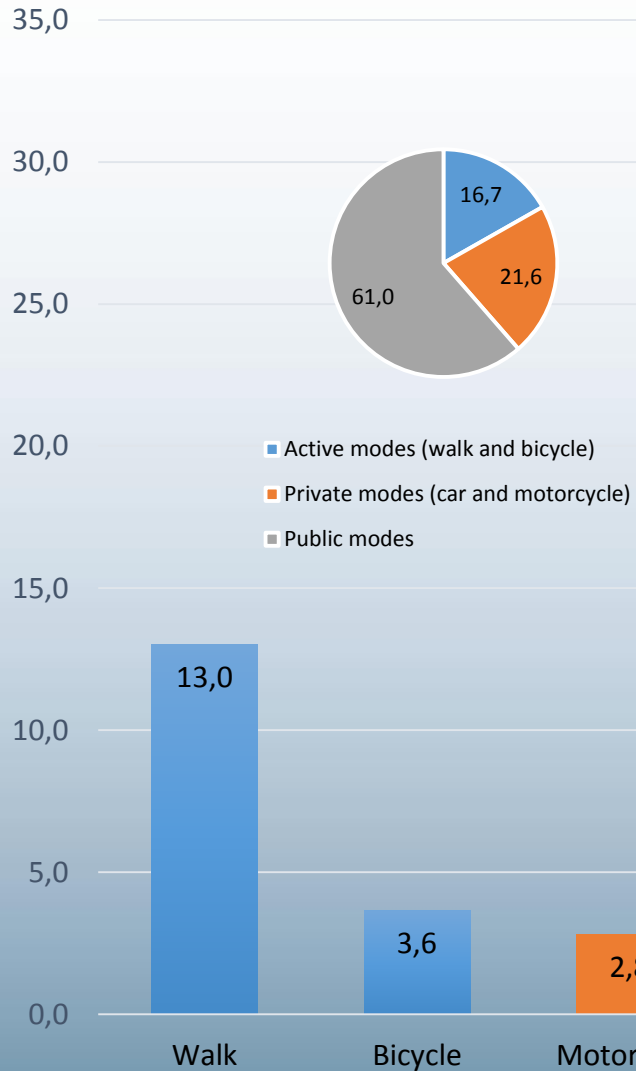

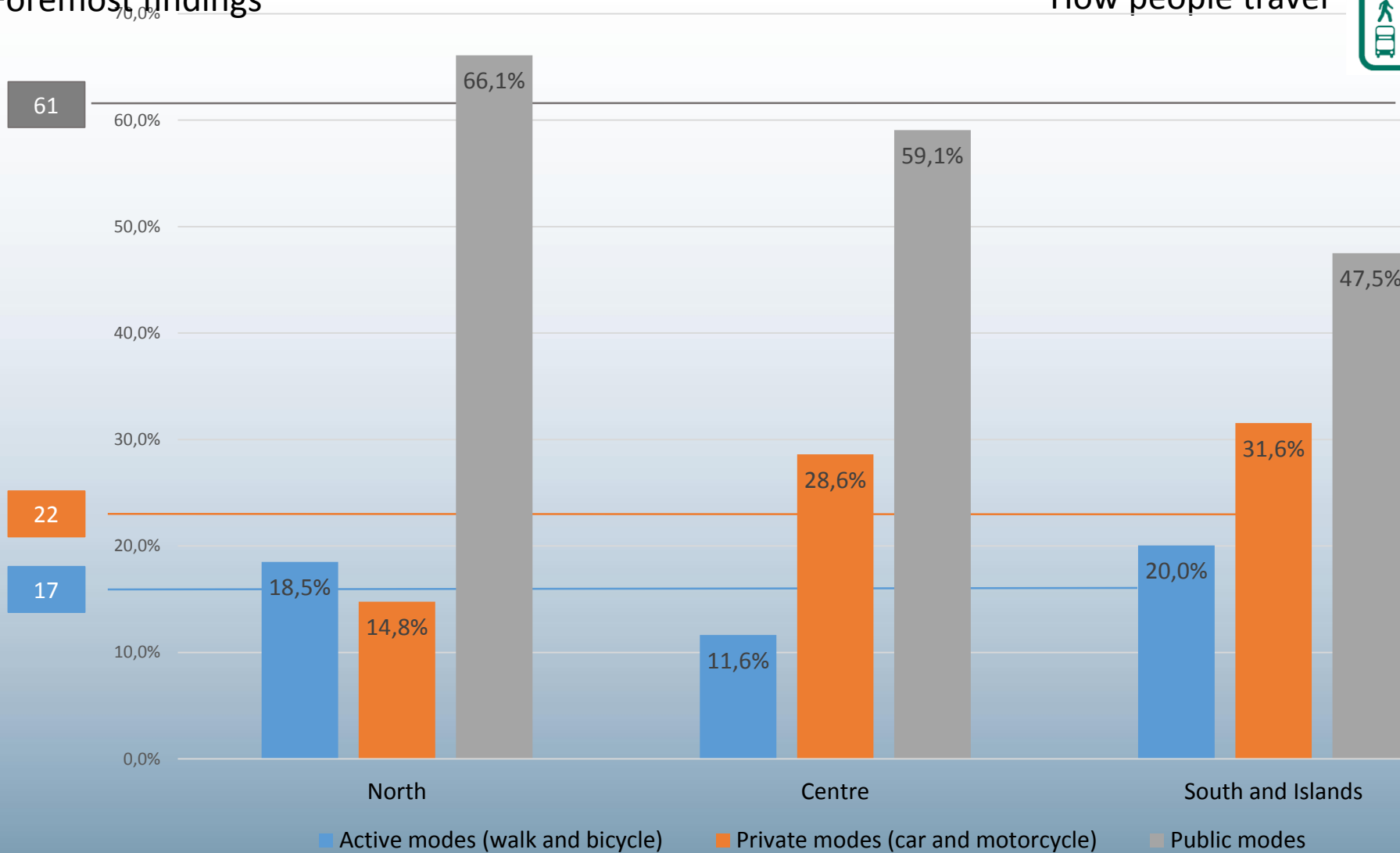


Mode used for the longest distance



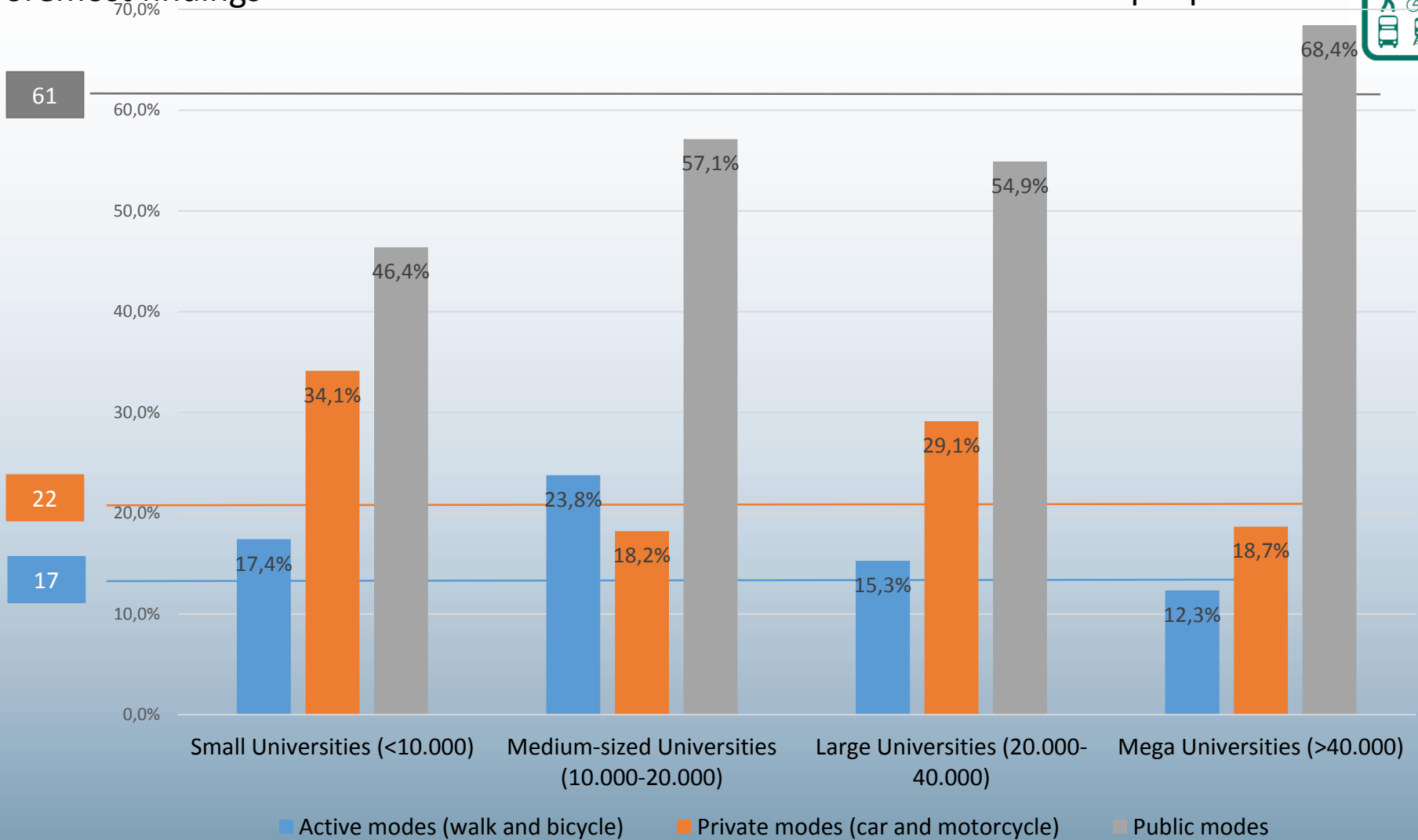

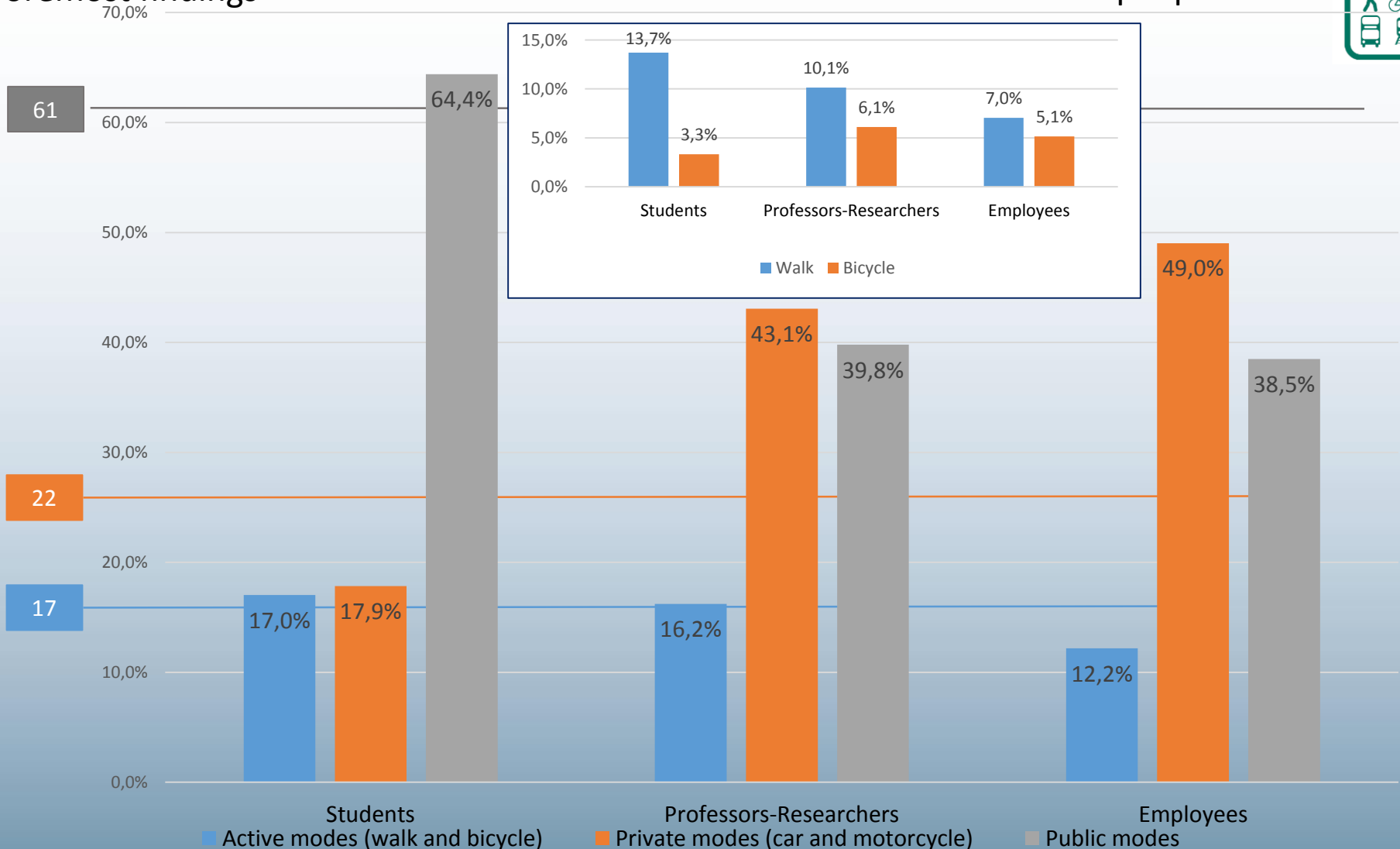

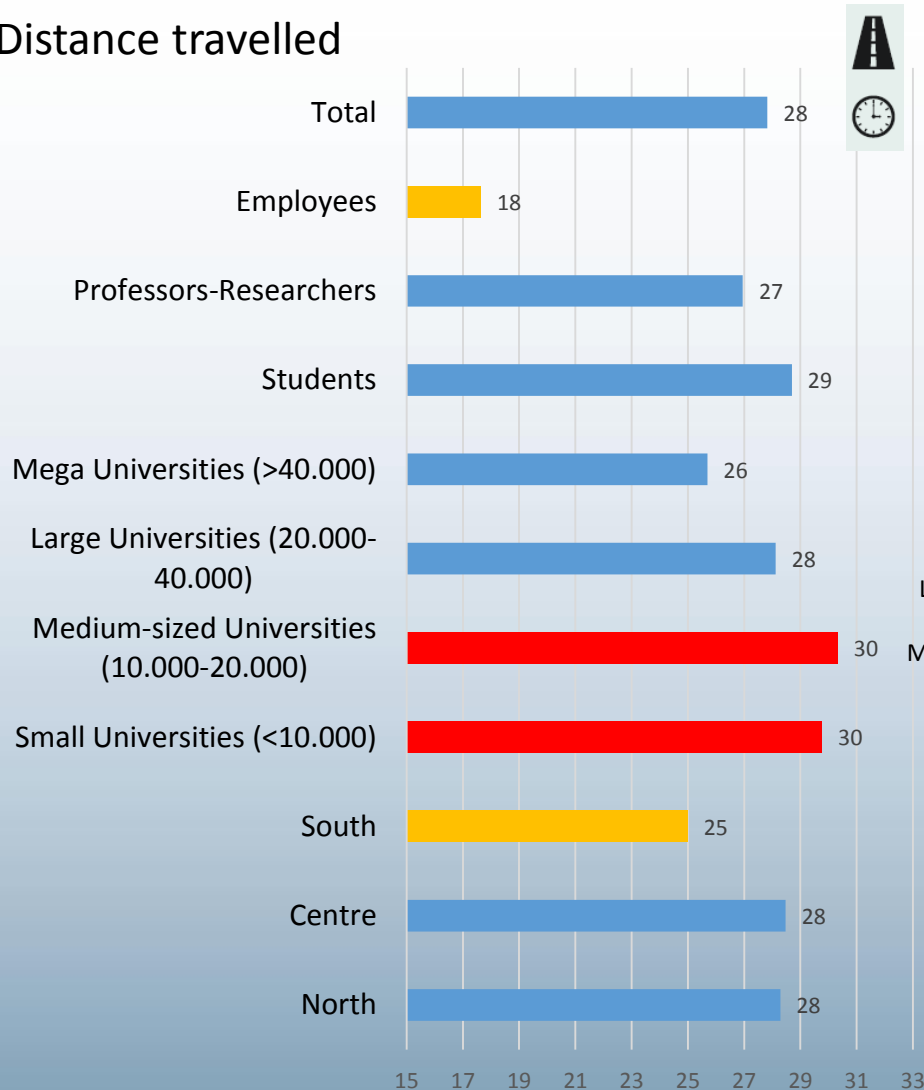

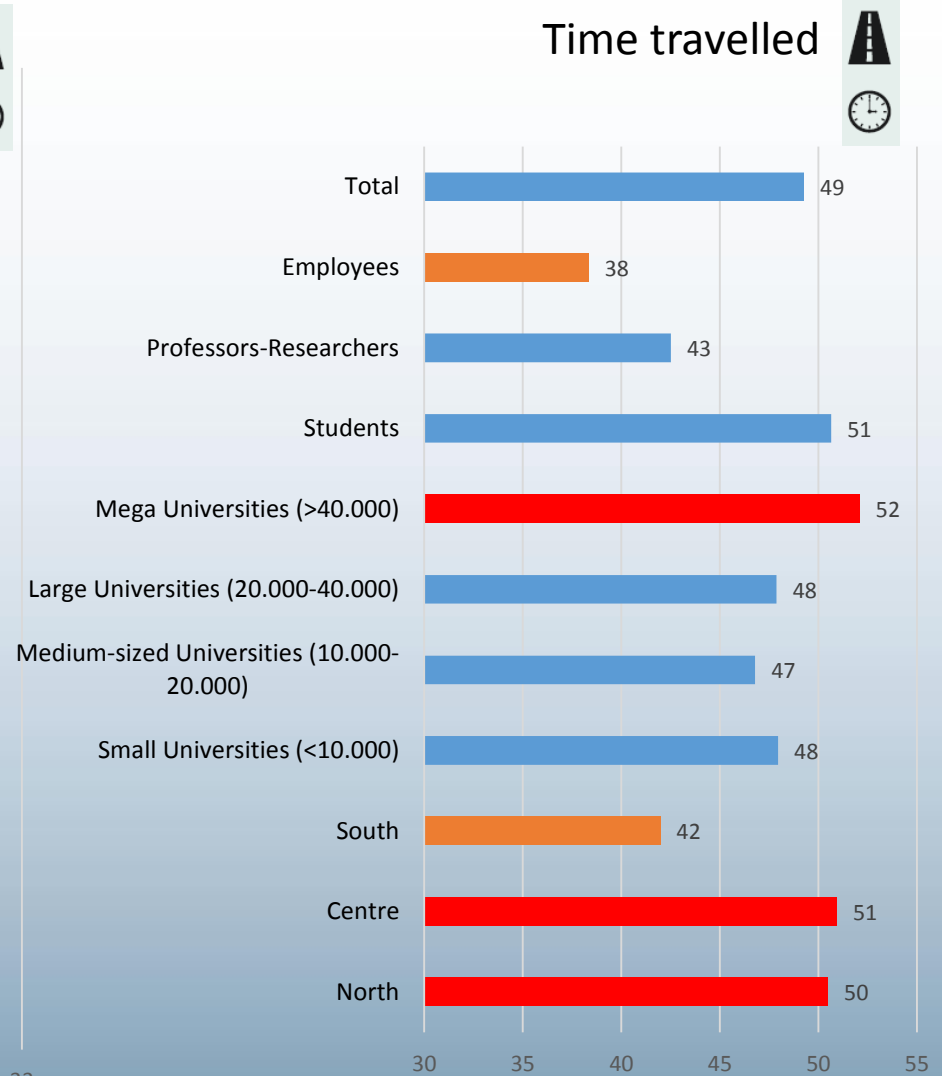

Distance (Km travelled) from home to the University

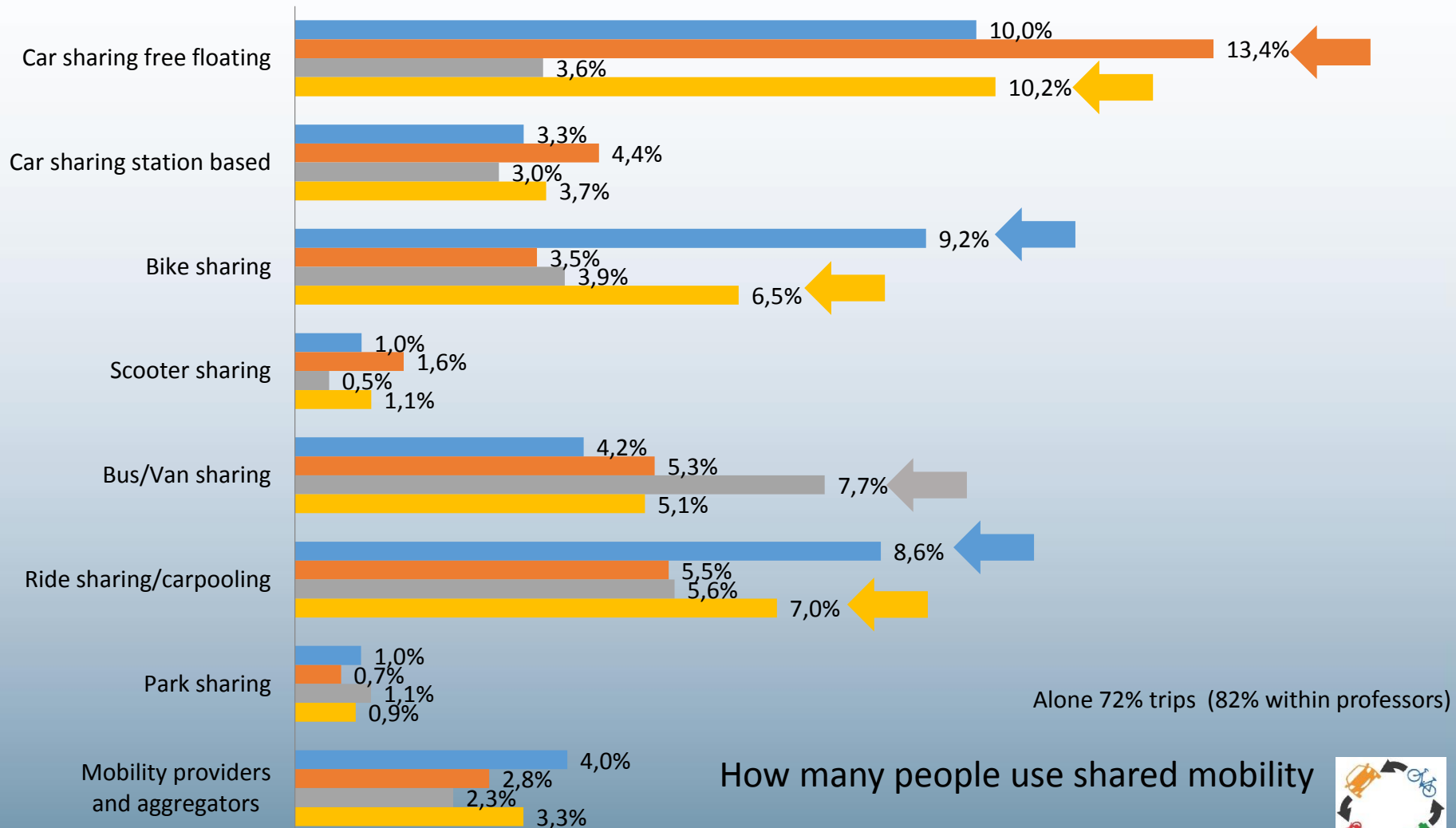
Time travelled

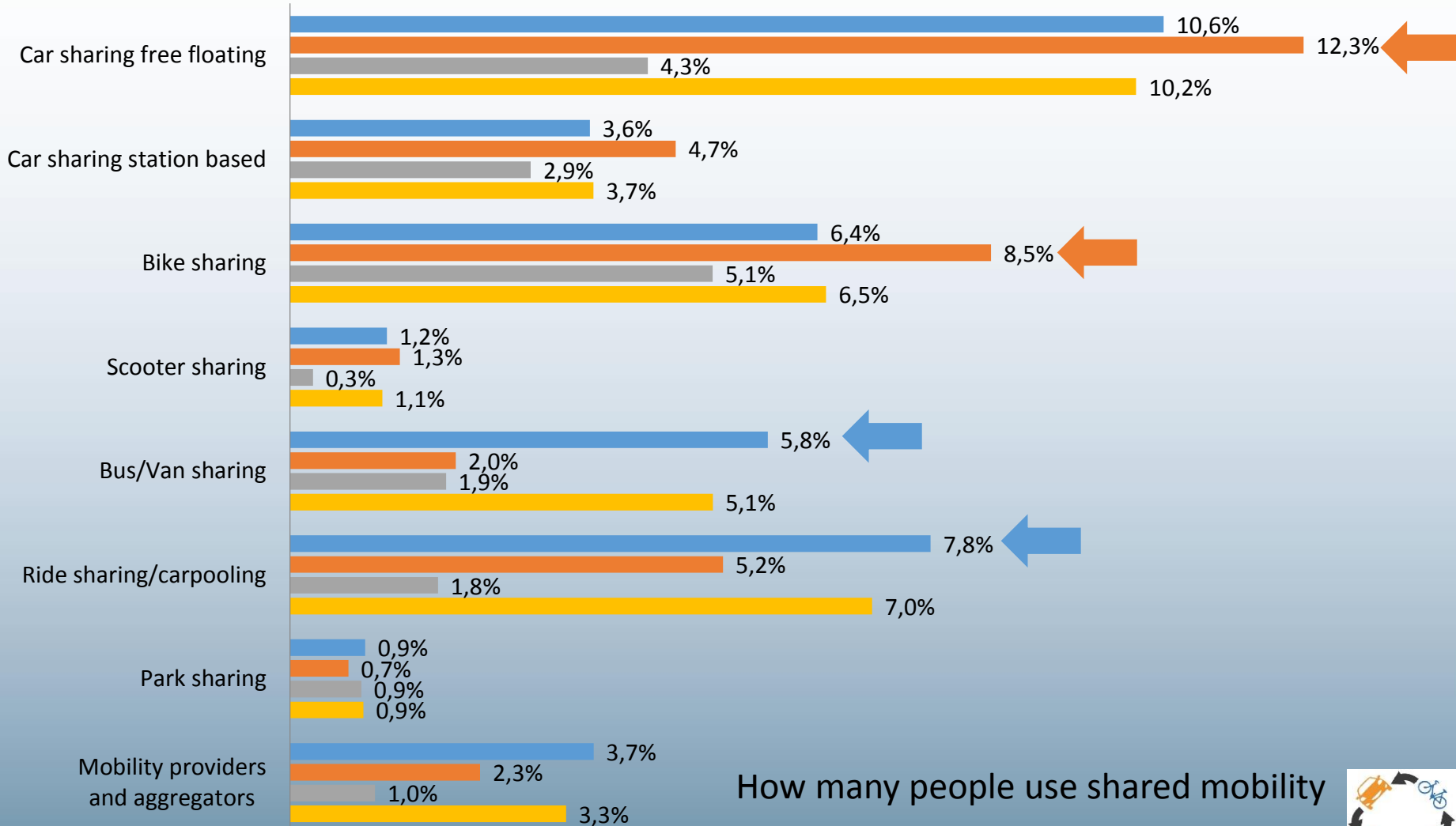


How many people use shared mobility

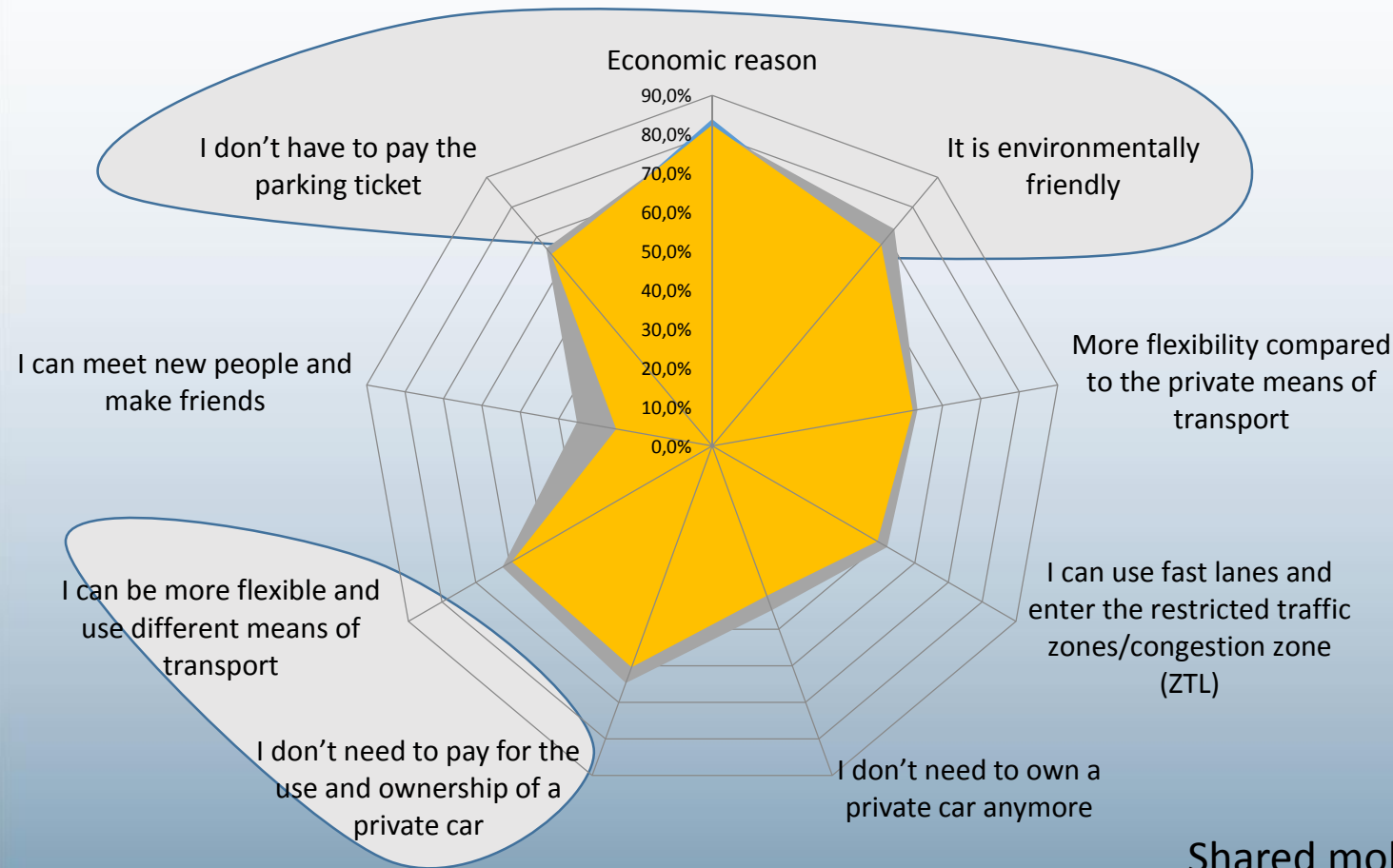

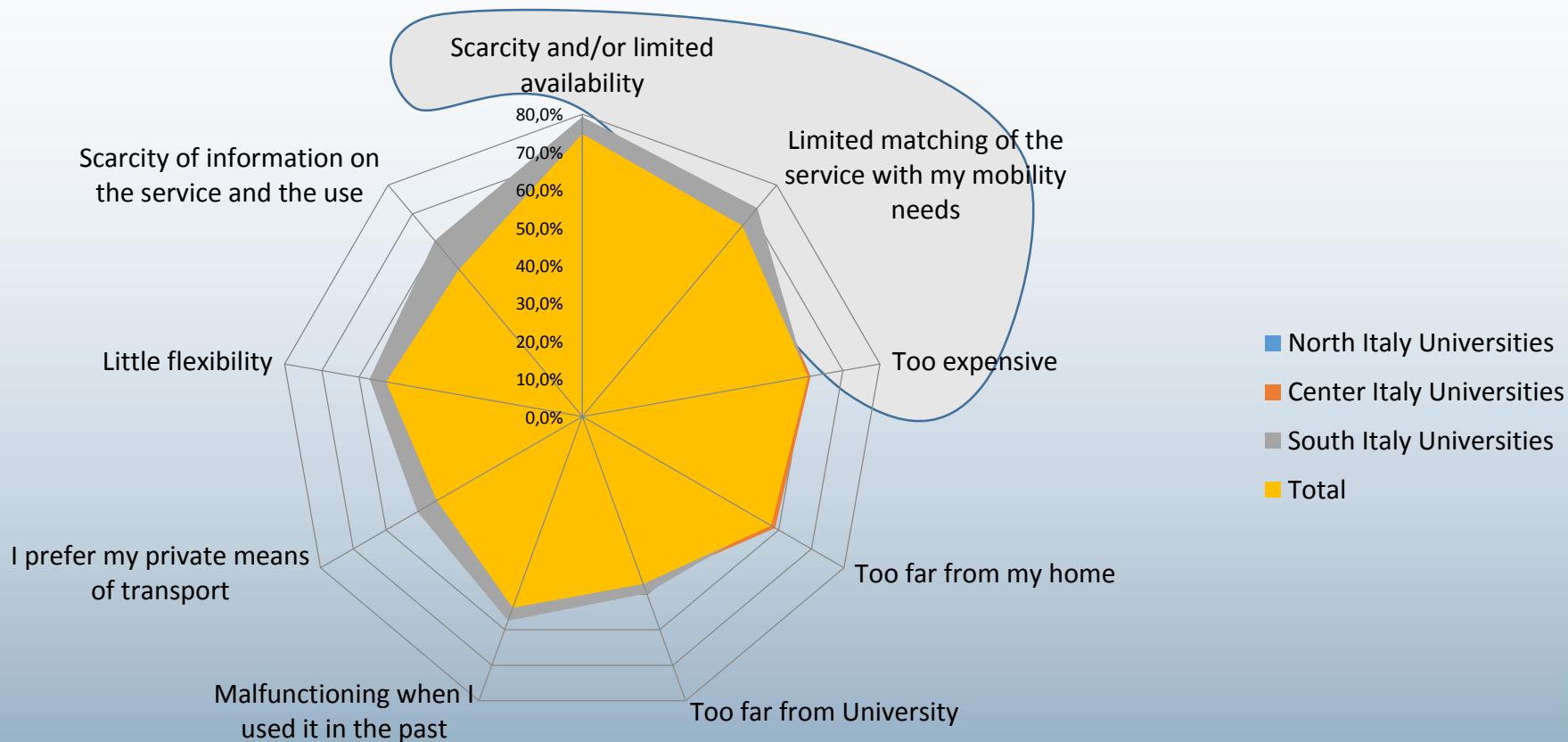

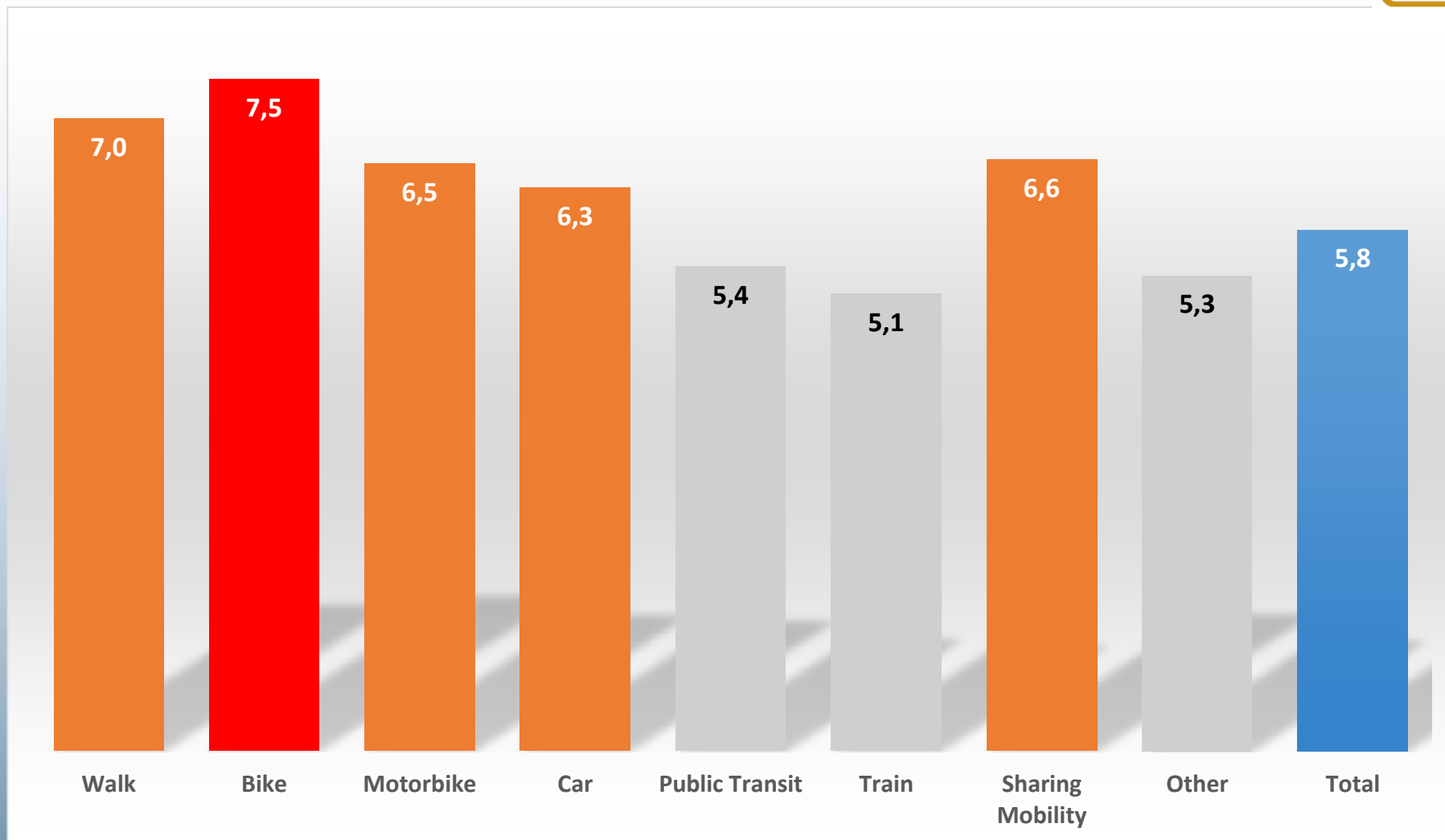

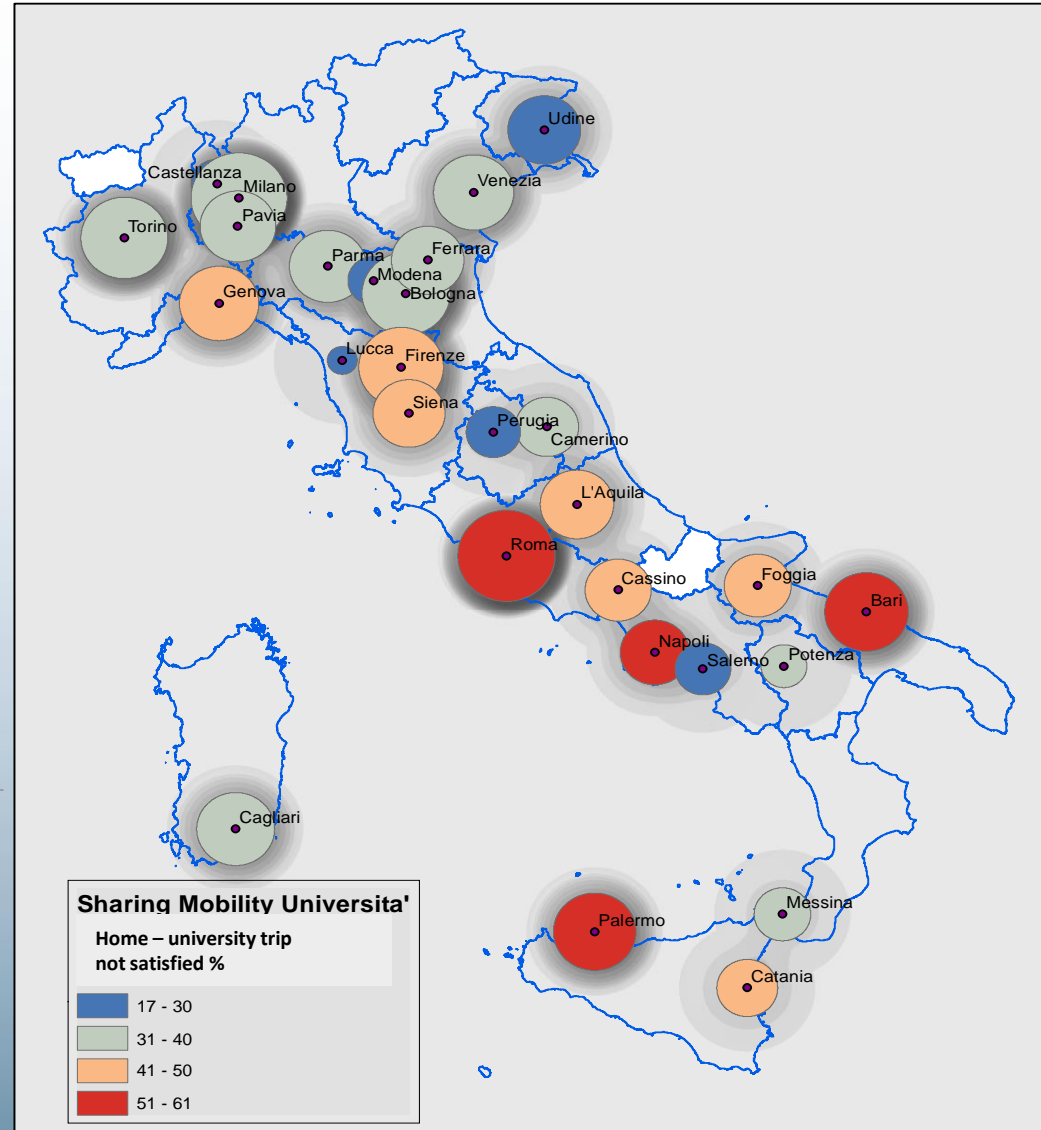

To sum up

A rich source of comparative data on commuting patterns of substantial groups of academic populations



Findings enable to examine concerns rarely investigated at a national level



Compare these findings with those achieved in other surveys carried out by universities not included in this enquiry



Over-estimation of active people and need of a more effective and widespread communication campaign

More in depth analysis will be presented in a national conference on “Mobility, access and right to education” which will be held in Milan on the 10th of May.
